Entrapment	Those climbing or abseiling	No Jewellery and long hair to be tied up			
Loose personal equipment	All participants	Harnesses to be checked by supervisor before each climb. Check helmet is correctly fitted.			
Tidiness	All participants	Unused equipment will be stored either in boxes or on the benches			
Playing around	All participants	Those waiting their turn will sit on the benches			
Trips from top of tower	All Participants	Safety rope to be erected and secured to the tower. When participants arrive on top, they are to be attached to the rope			
Spinning Holds	All Participants	Holds Spin due to compression of boards in some weathers. All Climbers to be attached to safety rope and climb only when someone is belaying
